- 1. All students are hereby informed that as per directives and instructions of Savitribai Phule Pune University, End Sem theory examination of SE (2019),TE (2019),BE (2019), BE (2015) will be conducted in offline mode.It will be conducted from 6th June to 4th July 2023.

Time table is available on our college website. It is also displayed on college notice board. Candidates are requested to see the Notice Board of the college regularly for changes if any that may be notified later in the program.

- 3. Students should note that **No reexamination will be conducted for any** reasons.
- 4. Students will not bring any kind of electronic device except standard scientific non programmable calculator in exam hall. There will be no inscription on writings on the calculator. Possession of mobiles, smart watch or any such device during the exam will be treated as malpractice. All bags will be kept on ground floor near reception. College will not be responsible for any kind of loss of bags or items in it. Hence it is advised not to carry anything other than writing material, hall ticket, I-card and permitted scientific calculator in academic block while coming for examination.
- 5. Toilets on first floor are assigned to be used by students during examination session. **No other toilet is permitted** to be used by students appearing for exam. If used by student, it will be treated as malpractice and strict action will be taken. Use of toilet more than once will be treated as malpractice. If student is sick, necessary permission in this regard may be requested to senior supervisor/CEO before starting of Examination.

For Backlog Examination students can use Gents toilets (Room no 146) & ladies toilet (Room no 127) on first floor.

For Regular Examination students can use Gents toilets (Room no 146 and toilet near E&TC dept Tutorial room2) & ladies toilets (Room no 127 and toilet near E&TC dept Tutorial room2) on first floor.

- 6. All students will wear floaters/chappals during exam. Shoes are not allowed. Use of blazer or jacket is not permitted in exam hall. If student is sick, necessary permission in this regard may be requested to senior supervisor/CEO before starting of examination.
- 7. Students will not be permitted to appear without <u>hall ticket and college I-</u>card
- 8. Students are advised not to indulge to any kind of malpractice during exam. Strict action will be taken for anyone adopting any kind of malpractice during examination.
- 9. Candidates are required to be present at the examination centre, THIRTY MINUTES before the stipulated time.
- 10. The exchanges of side-rules, drawing instruments of other materials used in the examination hall is not permitted at the time of examination. Candidates must bring their own instruments and will not be allowed to borrow from each other under any circumstances.
