Graph showing feedback of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering students for the Teachers (The graphical representation of the data is presented as below)



Analysis of feedback:

The feedback sessions, conducted twice during each semester, aimed to assess teaching effectiveness across ten parameters. Students provided ratings ranging from "Poor" to "Excellent." The scores were averaged for each parameter, and the results were analyzed in terms of mid-semester and end-semester evaluations, as well as comparisons between the two semesters.

The mid-semester feedback indicated a generally positive perception across most parameters. Notable strengths included commendable scores in communication skills, presentation, and syllabus coverage. However, certain areas, such as attitude towards students, firmness in maintaining discipline, and punctuality, revealed room for improvement.

The end-semester feedback demonstrated noticeable improvements compared to mid-semester evaluations. Significant enhancements were observed in communication skills, the ability to explain subject matter, and the overall interest created in the subject. Attitude towards students, class discipline, and punctuality also showed positive shifts, indicating a positive trend over the course of the semester.

In comparing the two semesters, common positive trends emerged. Communication skills witnessed improvement from mid to end semester in both Semester 1 and Semester 2. Similarly, the parameter of overall interest created in the subject displayed positive shifts. The action taken to focus on communication methods and strategies to increase student motivation seemed effective in both semesters.

Overall intrest created in subject & motivation to learn the subject remained an area that, while showing improvement, could benefit from further emphasis. Additionally, the teacher's attitude towards students, while improving, continued to be an area for ongoing enhancement, particularly in terms of approachability.

Several proactive measures were implemented to address the identified areas for improvement. Workshops were conducted to enhance teachers' approachability and counseling skills. Interactive teaching methods were introduced to encourage discussions and dynamic presentations, utilizing ICT tools effectively. Regular feedback sessions were initiated to ensure continuous improvement and address concerns promptly. Syllabus planning was improved to ensure coverage and included a focus on relevant topics beyond the syllabus.

The feedback and action taken report reflects an overall positive trajectory in teaching effectiveness. Notable improvements were observed in communication, motivation, and overall teaching methodologies. The critical comments provided valuable insights for ongoing enhancements. The consistent implementation of action plans and workshops has contributed to positive shifts in student perceptions. Continuous monitoring and adaptability will further contribute to sustained improvement in subsequent semesters.




Graph showing feedback of Information Technology students for the Teachers (The graphical representation of the data is presented as below)

Students' Feedback for Teachers: Sem 1 Mid sem

















Students' Feedback for Teachers: Sem 1 End sem

- 1. It is attributed from the graph that 94% (80% and 14%) of the students said that the Communication Skills i.e. Teacher's ability to communicate the Subject clearly & audibly is excellent and very good respectively.
- 2. It can be seen from pie chart that 95% students said that teachers are regular and punctual in taking classes and teachers Attitude towards students (i.e. in terms of being approachable, providing guidance, advice and counselling) is excellent and very good.

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

Graph showing feedback of Information Technology students for the Teachers (The graphical representation of the data is presented as below)









Graph showing feedback of Information Technology students for the Teachers (The graphical representation of the data is presented as below)

Students' Feedback for Teachers: Sem 1 Mid sem






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









Students' Feedback for Teachers: Sem 1 End sem








Graph showing feedback of Information Technology students for the Teachers (The graphical representation of the data is presented as below)


Students' Feedback for Teachers: Sem 1 Mid sem













Students' Feedback for Teachers: Sem 1 End sem



Analysis of feedback:

The feedback sessions, conducted twice during each semester, aimed to assess teaching effectiveness across ten parameters. Students provided ratings ranging from "Poor" to "Excellent." The scores were averaged for each parameter, and the results were analyzed in terms of mid-semester and end-semester evaluations, as well as comparisons between the two semesters.

The mid-semester feedback indicated a generally positive perception across most parameters. Notable strengths included commendable scores in communication skills, presentation, and syllabus coverage. However, certain areas, such as attitude towards students, firmness in maintaining discipline, and punctuality, revealed room for improvement.

The end-semester feedback demonstrated noticeable improvements compared to mid-semester evaluations. Significant enhancements were observed in communication skills, the ability to explain subject matter, and the overall interest created in the subject. Attitude towards students, class discipline, and punctuality also showed positive shifts, indicating a positive trend over the course of the semester.

In comparing the two semesters, common positive trends emerged. Communication skills witnessed improvement from mid to end semester in both Semester 1 and Semester 2. Similarly, the parameter of overall interest created in the subject displayed positive shifts. The action taken to focus on communication methods and strategies to increase student motivation seemed effective in both semesters.

Punctuality remained an area that, while showing improvement, could benefit from further emphasis. Additionally, the teacher's attitude towards students, while improving, continued to be an area for ongoing enhancement, particularly in terms of approachability.

Several proactive measures were implemented to address the identified areas for improvement. A concerted effort was made to emphasize punctuality and regularity through reminders and incentives. Workshops were conducted to enhance teachers' approachability and counseling skills. Interactive teaching methods were introduced to encourage discussions and dynamic presentations, utilizing ICT tools effectively. Regular feedback sessions were initiated to ensure





continuous improvement and address concerns promptly. Syllabus planning was improved to ensure coverage and included a focus on relevant topics beyond the syllabus.

The feedback and action taken report reflects an overall positive trajectory in teaching effectiveness.

Notable improvements were observed in communication, motivation, and overall teaching methodologies.

The critical comments provided valuable insights for ongoing enhancements. The consistent

implementation of action plans and workshops has contributed to positive shifts in student perceptions.

Continuous monitoring and adaptability will further contribute to sustained improvement in subsequent semesters.






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
Students' Feedback for Teachers: Sem 2 Mid sem














