


REDUCE

Avoid buying single use disposables such as plastic/paper cups, gift wraps and packaged products. Many packages which are a combination of paper, foil and plastic are often difficult to recycle. Carry your own grocery bag every time you shop instead of accepting single use plastic carry bags. **Reducing the waste at source removes the need to manage it later!**

REUSE

Re-use old glass jars and plastic covers. You can give second life to your old clothes, books and electronic items by repairing them.

RECYCLE

Recycling is an energy intensive process. However, it is a better option than landfilling. Recycling helps salvage raw materials that would be lost forever if landfilled


ELIMINATION OF SINGLE USE PLASTIC

1. Ref HQ AWES letter No B/45785/Misc/AWES dated 01 Apr 2021 on the subject.
2. We produce millions of tons of single use plastic every year, most of which cannot be recycled. Single use plastic includes plastic bags, polythene straws, plastic glass, soda and water bottles and food packaging items etc. These single use plastics are used only once and then thrown away.
3. **Single use plastic** is very harmful for human beings, animals and marine creatures. Animals consume plastic particles along with their food. Plastic cannot be digested and thus gets trapped in their intestine and results in serious health problems. We need to understand the problems being caused by the **single use plastic** and stop their use. We should stop using single use plastic to protect our planet, environment and human beings.
